

We've worked hard to make Love Light Norwich as accessible as possible, and are working with community groups from across the city to bring people together. All of the festival is completely free, and the pieces have been chosen with accessibility in mind.



Sustainability \Diamond

All the installations have been made as energy efficient as possible. When choosing the work exhibited, the environmental impact was considered. Whenever possible, mains power is used rather than a generator, and the pieces will use low-energy LEDs.

Streetlights have been switched off or had the brightness reduced; saving power, and reducing light pollution. We have done our best to procure locally, and reduce the festival's overall carbon footprint.




